Employment Opportunity Family Development Worker

Job Purpose

The purpose of the Family Development Worker is to work with local Kensington-Cedar Cottage families with children 0-12 years old to participate in community life through an inclusion and belonging lens. The Family Development worker will work as part of a team to lead and deliver quality programming, community development projects, outreach and information and referral for families.

The primary functions of this position are:

- Family and Early Years Program Delivery – deliver quality early learning and parent education programming and working with partners to deliver programming, including Family Night programming
- Middle Years Programming and Support – Work with school aged children and their families in afterschool programming and school break periods
- Special Events – Working with a team to host Neighbourhood House special events
- Family Support – link families to resources, support families through applications, provide referrals and advocate for families
- Volunteer Engagement – Work with local parents, caregivers and youth to meaningfully contribute to special events, programs and projects through sharing their skills, ideas and energy with the Neighbourhood House
- Outreach to families – connect to other programming like Strong Starts, Food Banks etc. to connect with isolated families in our neighbourhood

This is a Tuesday – Saturday work schedule to include a weekly evening program (subject to change based on programming needs). Traveling from various locations will also be required.

Qualifications:

- Completion of a college or university program in social work, child and youth care, early childhood education, counseling or other social science or health-related discipline is preferred.
- Well developed interpersonal skills, including both written and oral communication
- 1-2 years experience working in a diverse setting with children and families
- Valid Criminal Record Search
