Our childcare team is passionate and inspired by the Reggio Emilia Approach and we apply its principles and values in concert with the values of FHNH. We are a Learning Centre with amazing opportunities for professional development and for collaborative efforts with other educators and with the community as a whole. As a member of the Association of Neighbourhood Houses of BC (ANHBC), FHNH is recognized for our innovative and inclusive approach in working with staff, volunteers and community.

### **Responsibilities:**

The Kids World School Age Care Support Worker will be responsible for overseeing the full integration of a 7 year old boy with autism who requires one to one extra support into the program. This also includes working together with the staff team and with the child to attain goals determined by Supported Childcare, and to provide personal care when required. We are an inclusive, multicultural, dynamic and collaborative child care setting which includes working with the other educators to plan and implement a progressive and an innovative program inspired by the Reggio Emilia approach. Other responsibilities include developing strong relationships and communication with children, families and colleagues, and implementing high standards of care and supervision that promote the well being of all children.

Completion of a 20 hour course, or a combination of courses in child development, guidance, health and safety, or nutrition  
Special Needs Training and Education  
First Aid Certificate  
Knowledge and experience in working with children with Autism is an asset

Passion for constant learning in partnership with children, families and colleagues  
An eagerness to work as part of a collaborative, supportive and dynamic team in a non-profit and volunteer-based organization  
Demonstrated ability to provide emergent programming based on the principles of the Reggio Emilia approach is an asset  
Ability to work in a multicultural environment  
Ability to work cooperatively in a non-profit and volunteer-based organization  
Second language is an asset
