Youth Programmer

The Youth Programmer works within a high-energy, creative, collaborative team to provide a variety of social, recreational and skill development activities for high school aged youth. The Youth Programmer is responsible for supporting the Youth Services Coordinator to plan, implement, and maintain the BASE, Youth Skills, and Scholarship & Bursary Programs in addition to the Youth Advisory Committee.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Plan and facilitate life skills workshops for groups of up to 50 youth
- Assist the Coordinator in facilitating programs at Vancouver Technical Secondary School
- Plan and organize large scaled community events and out-trips
- Accompany youth on tours of local post-secondary institutions
- Assist youth completing applications for scholarships and bursaries
- Convene and chair Youth Advisory Committee meetings as required
- Supervise, orient, and motivate youth participants and volunteers
- Mediate, counsel, and act as a role model for participants/volunteers
- Communicate with local teachers, counselors and administrators to ensure we are meeting the needs of local newcomer youth
- Provide a physically and emotionally safe environment for all program participants, staff and volunteers
- Empower youth through actively encouraging their involvement in program planning
- Maintain excellent program standards; conduct program evaluations and monitor targets
- Ensure the safe keeping and proper use of FHNH facilities and equipment, as well as host facilities, and equipment

Qualifications:

- At least 2 years of experience working with youth ages 14-18
- Post-secondary education in child and youth work, recreation, social work, or similar discipline
- Excellent workshop facilitation skills
- Demonstrated skills in outreach, program planning, implementation and evaluation
- Broad knowledge of community resources available for youth, and working relationships with local youth service providers
