Position: Preteen Programmers (2 positions)

Cedar Cottage Neighbourhood House is looking for 2 Youth and Pre-teen Workers to develop and lead a summer program for 10-14 year olds to participate in a program about gardening, sustainability and climate action.

These positions are for individuals between 19 to 30 years who are interested in working with youth and pre-teens aged from 10-14. These programs focus on delivering a fun, safe, and positive environment designed for the interest and engagement of 10-14 year olds. Any interested candidate must have experience working with 10-14 year olds in a safe, social recreational setting.
