Youth Mental Health Worker (RCC)

The Youth Mental Health Worker facilitates workshops for group sessions and meets with youth who express they need mental health support. The candidate will be well versed in cultural competency, trauma informed support, and the stigma surrounding mental health care in many cultures, which has been identified by youth participants. Based out of Frog Hollow Neighbourhood House, they will collaborate with a high-energy, client-focused team to deliver exceptional youth settlement services in East Vancouver.

We strongly encourage applications from people who identify as Black, Indigenous, and People of Colour (BIPOC), individuals with disabilities, and members of the LGBTQIA2S+ communities.

Position: Youth Mental Health Worker
Hours: 14 hours/week minimum (Tuesday – Saturday)

Responsibilities:

- Identify newcomer preteens and youth ages 16-30 overcoming culture shock and trauma-related barriers in society and provide referrals to crisis services
- Develop curriculum addressing culture shock and trauma-related barriers for newcomer preteens and youth ages 16-30
- Facilitate workshops on a regular basis for newcomer preteens/youth
- Ensure programs are safe, accessible and inviting to preteens/youth of all cultural backgrounds
- Compile a community resource library accessible to preteens and youth
- Develop and facilitate staff trainings including but not limited to mental health awareness and trauma-informed practice
- Maintain up to date knowledge of community resources and youth programs
- Support the work of, and collaborate with, the settlement team to ensure smooth implementation and operations

Qualifications:

- Registered Clinical Counselor designation
- Motivated, enthusiastic individual with at least 2 years of experience providing counselling services to survivors of violence and trauma
- At least 2 years of experience working with multi-barriered preteens and youth ages 10-30, including newcomer youth
- Exceptional knowledge of youth-specific issues
- Skilled workshop facilitator
- Second language an asset
