Job Description

Gordon Neighbourhood House's Licensed Out of School Care program is looking for a Supported Childcare Worker to oversee the inclusion of children with extra support needs into exciting and educational programming for children ages 5 – 10. The Supported Childcare Worker will assist in fostering positive interactions between the student and their peers; implement individualized programs and activities while focusing on building independence; and provide personal care: dressing, toileting (may include diaper changes), feeding, lifting/transfers (ie. to and from wheelchair). Must be able to lift 50lbs.

Rate of pay: \$21.69/hour

Hours of work: Monday – Friday 3:00 – 6:00 pm, with full days during school closures

Qualifications

- Early Childhood Education or equivalent (CCYC, Social Work preferred)
- Experience and/or training in working with children with Cerebral Palsy
- Meet all requirement of the Childcare Licensing Regulations
- Must be atleast 19 years of age
- Minimum 20 hours of training or courses related to working with children or child development.
- Hold a valid First Aid Certificate
- Written and verbal communication skills
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills
- Ability to plan and implement social activities and recreational experiences for children
- An ability to create and maintain a calm and flexible environment
