Alex House operates multiple sites in Surrey & White Rock, with our main facility in Crescent Beach, where we operate on the stolen and occupied land of Semiahmoo Nation. We offer programs and activities that contribute to a vibrant, caring and inclusive community, and we are committed to decolonizing our approach, while ensuring an anti-racism approach.

The successful candidate will demonstrate a proven record of working independently, superior communication skills, and be able to work effectively with team members, volunteers, program participants, and the general public. We are looking to fill multiple positions for our Alex House sites – Camp Alex in Crescent Beach, Kensington Prairie on 32nd Ave. & 160th St., and Elgin on Crescent Road & 145th St., all in South Surrey.

Reporting to the Coordinator, Building Services in collaboration with the Coordinator, Retreat & Event Centre.

Duties:

1. Janitorial –

- Weekday cleaning of childcare and program spaces.
- Replenish paper/cleaning supplies in all buildings, as needed.
- As assigned – evening cleaning of childcare and program spaces.
- Site cleanliness incl. cleaning of outdoor garbage containers.

2. Maintenance –

- General maintenance over weekday incl. plugged toilets/sink, flooding, breakers etc. and/or call external service provider when unable to remedy. Non urgent issues will be referred to Property Manager.

- Minimum 3 years building services work
