About the position: The supervisor is responsible to provide leadership in the delivery of a licensed school age program both before and after school. Queen Alexandra will be expanding to 65 spaces in September and we will be operating out of a portable and the lunchroom of the school. The key responsibilities:

- Be familiar with current licensing regulations, policies, and is responsible to implement them as directed.
- Plan and conducts staff meetings, reviews timesheets, ensures child records are maintained and do fieldtrip and activity calendar planning.
- Work in collaboration with the Program Coordinator to plan, supervises and evaluate the work of staff, volunteers and students.
- Provide orientation to families to the program, meets with families when needed, communicates regularly with families.
- Work as a front-line childcare worker
