Cedar Cottage Neighbourhood House seeks an enthusiastic Seniors and Family Worker to lead programs for the seniors and families in our local community.

The Seniors and Family Worker will be a “people person” who is able to design and deliver quality programs for seniors and families to foster connections, to find resources and to meet new friends. All of the programs will be centred on the participants who will experience learning, laughter and some good food.

The Seniors and Family Worker will understand the importance of people coming together in programs such as a Family Coffee Time, Indigenous Cultural Programs, Soup and Sandwich Family Drop In, Seniors Supper Club and participant led activities (E.g. seniors sing along, family painting classes).

This is a Tuesday – Saturday work schedule (September-June) and Monday-Friday (July and August).

Qualifications:

- Completion of a college or university program in social work, child and youth care, counseling, or a related social science or health field.
- One year of relevant experience, or a combination of education, training, and experience.
- Experience in planning and delivering programs focused for seniors and families.
- Experience working with children and families in diverse cultural settings.
- Early Childhood Education (ECE) and/or early learning.
- Strong communication, relationship-building, and program planning skills.
- Good interpersonal skills, including both written and verbal communication.
